

5.16 COMMUNITY DISRUPTION

As the Proposed Action is primarily the replacement of an existing use, it is consistent with the character of the project area. No neighborhoods would be divided or altered, and cohesion of the community would not be affected by the Proposed Action. As a result, no adverse impacts to the community would result from the project. As noted in Chapter 1, the purpose of the South Ferry Terminal Project is to replace the existing substandard station with a new terminal that addresses the functional and operational deficiencies of the existing station, to support the economic recovery and revitalization of the Lower Manhattan area. Thus, the project would contribute to the regeneration of this area of the City and provide improved connectivity with other transit services to the area.
