By train: Take Metro-North's Hudson Line to Croton-Harmon Station for shuttle bus service to the shop. Check timetable for scheduled trains.

By car: From New York City, take the New York State Thruway to Exit 9, Tarrytown. Turn left onto Route 119 for $\frac{2}{10}$ mile. Turn right onto Route 9 and continue north for 14 miles. After crossing Croton River Bridge, take the first exit, Croton Point Avenue. Follow signs to free parking. From Stamford and White Plains, take Interstate 287 to the New York State Thruway entrance at Elmsford and follow the directions above.
