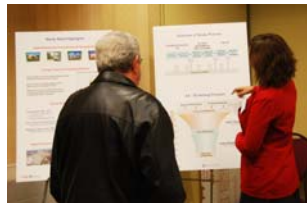


# Public Involvement in the Process
