

MTA NYC Transit is looking to hire Provisional Power Cable Maintainers

We offer a comprehensive benefits package; paid holidays, vacation and sick leave; promotional opportunities; a pension plan; a deferred compensation plan; and a FREE NYC Transit transportation pass.

The starting salary is: \$26.64 per hour for a 40-hour work week, PLUS night and weekend pay differentials.

Job Description: You will maintain and repair both high-voltage power feeder cable systems running between generating plants, substations and circuit breaker houses, and low-voltage communication cable systems routed between Main Distribution Frames and telephone terminal boxes throughout the system. You will work both above and below ground and in confined spaces such as manholes; splice both single- and multi-conductor cables; and may be required to handle asbestos-containing materials.

Qualifying Requirements: Three years of full-time journey-level experience as an: (1) electrical line worker or power distribution electrician installing and repairing high-voltage power distribution and transmission lines, equipment and systems, and industrial power cables; or (2) telecommunications line worker installing and repairing multi-conductor communication cables in industrial applications; or (3) industrial electrician installing and repairing high-voltage cables, lines and electrical equipment in industrial applications.

For the above journey-level experience to be credited, it must be preceded by one of the following:

(1) Two years of helper/trainee experience as listed above; or (2) Graduation from a vocational high school, or a post-secondary trade or technical school, or college with a major in the electrical field.

The following types of experience are not acceptable: general residential or commercial electrical work installing and repairing low-voltage (**120 or 240 volts**) lighting, power or climate control systems and equipment; single-conductor communications wiring and equipment (i.e., cable TV, intercoms, fire and security alarm systems, telephones) in residential and commercial buildings and structures.

Driver License Requirement: You must have a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York.
