

Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Changes in Traffic Pattern and Parking Removal on Eastchester Road near Bassett Avenue

The Penn Station Access Project will need to modify the traffic pattern and parking on Eastchester Road, near Bassett Avenue, to safely perform track work and substructure repairs on the Eastchester Road Bridge situated above the roadway and on the steel beams below the bridge.

Beginning on or about January 13, 2025, curbside parking will be removed on both sides of the street, and Eastchester Road will be reduced to one travel lane in each direction, with intermittent full road closures as overhead work progresses at the site. The pedestrian pathways will be maintained on both sides of the street at all times. These changes will be in place for approximately four (4) months. These modifications are necessary to safely perform work on the Eastchester Road Bridge substructure and center pier. We will continue to update the community as work on the Eastchester Road Bridge progresses in the upcoming months. We appreciate your understanding and patience while we advance this vital transit equity project.
