

Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Intermittent Nightly Work through December 2025: Sackett Avenue between Eastchester Road and Bronxdale Avenue

Intermittent nightly construction for the Penn Station Access project will occur between the hours of 10:00 pm and 7:00 am through December 2025. Crews will be performing work on the tracks and drainage system within the Amtrak right-of-way (ROW), along Sackett Avenue between Eastchester Road and Bronxdale Avenue. This work must be performed overnight, to maintain existing rail service along Northeast Corridor, the most heavily used passenger rail corridor in the U.S. This work will require excavation and the use of noise generating equipment. Our contractor has a sound mitigation plan in place compliant with NYC Noise Control Code and DEP guidelines. Please see map below for work zone boundaries.
