



# **Metro-North Railroad Service Plans for NJ Transit Strike**

# A NJ Transit strike would affect West of Hudson Metro-North riders on the Pascack Valley and Port Jervis Lines

- Metro-North customers on West of Hudson service depend on NJ Transit to reach Hoboken or Secaucus Junction, and ultimately NY Penn Station
- A strike by NJ Transit train operators could begin on Friday May 16 at 12:01 AM
- In the event of a strike, there will be no Metro-North West of Hudson service



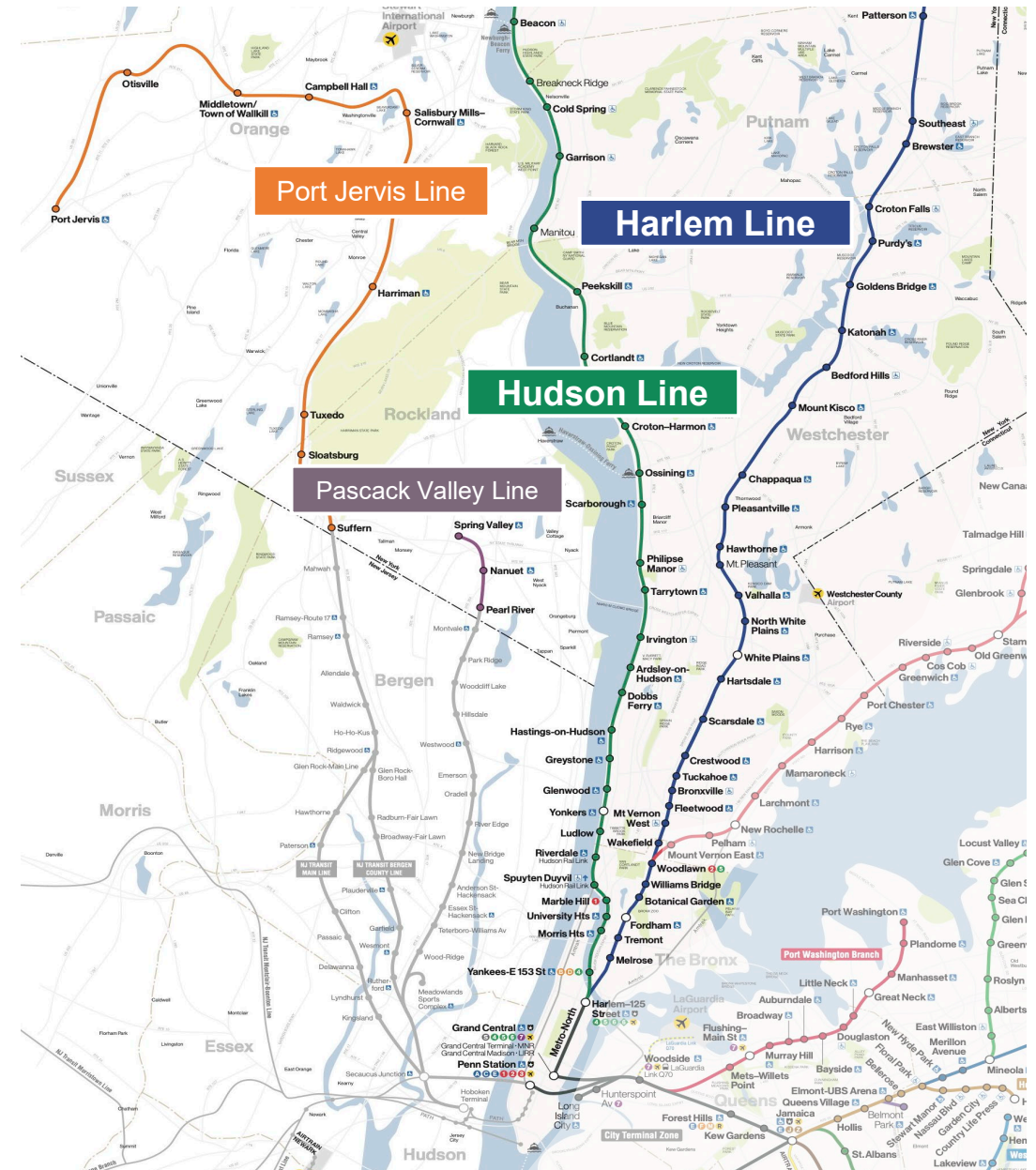
# West of Hudson riders have a great alternative: The Hudson and Harlem Lines

Metro-North will accommodate its West of Hudson customers on the Hudson and Harlem Lines:

- All fare tickets will be cross-honored
- Parking will be cross-honored at five stations (Cortlandt, Beacon, New Hamburg, Poughkeepsie and North White Plains)
- Free bus and ferry connections for West of Hudson ticket holders
- The Hudson Line will operate with additional train cars

Metro-North will monitor ridership to determine additional service needs for:

- Shuttle bus or ferry service across the river
- Train service on Hudson or Harlem Lines



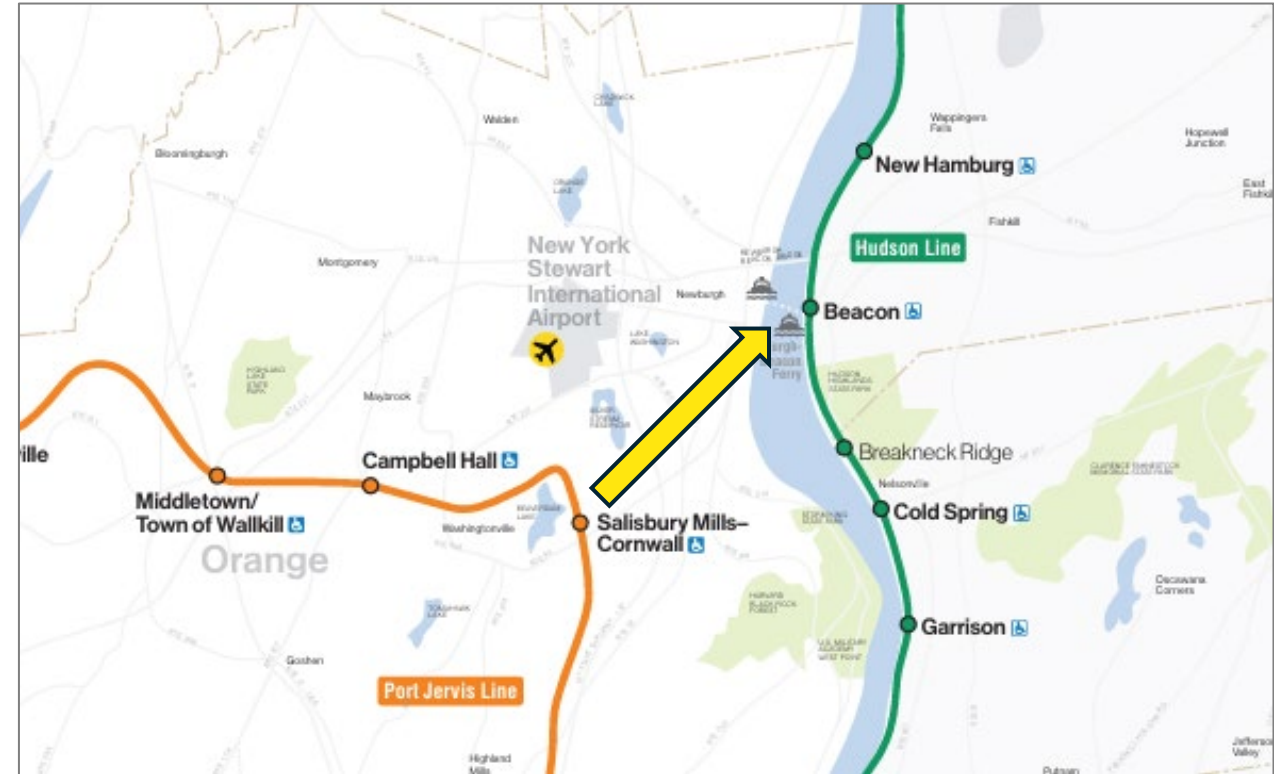
# Example: Salisbury Mills to Manhattan

## Current West of Hudson trip

- Drive to Salisbury Mills Station on the Port Jervis Line
- Choice of 5 morning AM rush trains
- 87 minutes to Secaucus Transfer and then NY Penn (March OTP: 90.9%)

## East of Hudson alternative

- Drive to Beacon Station on the Hudson Line
- Parking is cross-honored
- Choice of 12 morning AM rush trains from Beacon
- 78-minute, one-seat ride to Grand Central (March OTP: 99.1%)





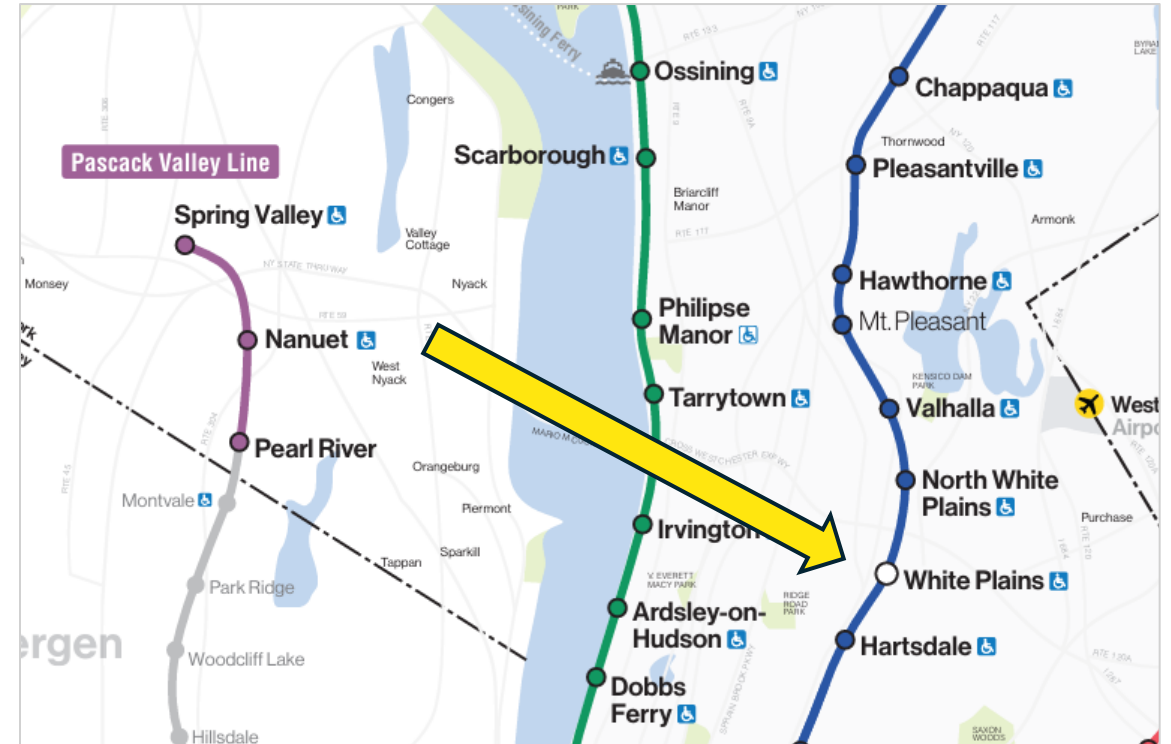
# Example: Nanuet to Manhattan

## Current West of Hudson trip

- Drive to Nanuet Station on the Pascack Valley Line
- Choice of 9 morning AM rush trains
- 84 minutes to Secaucus Transfer and then NY Penn (March OTP: 92%)

## East of Hudson alternative

- Drive to Palisades Center Mall Park and Ride
- Take the bus to White Plains Station on the Harlem Line
- Hudson Link fare and parking are cross-honored
- Choice of 28 morning AM rush trains
- 36 minutes on the train to Grand Central (March OTP: 98.8%)
