Since then, we've seen:


- Development in new areas

How we got here

Riders identified four priorities for the new network: reliable service, faster travel, better connections, and simplified service.

From these priorities, we developed several redesign strategies.



124,000

more people will have access to a bus that **arrives every 10 minutes or better**, 6 AM-9 PM (+5% over existing)



more people will have **access to 24-hour** bus service (+3% over existing)

We're adding, relocating, and removing hundreds of stops to make rides faster, more reliable, and more connected.



Changes to routes

We're rerouting some routes for faster and more direct service. And some routes are getting new numbers.



New routes

We're expanding the network with new and extended routes in more areas.



New Rush routes

Newly designed routes make local stops far from the subway, with limited stops on major streets and near hubs.


New route type


- Faster service to the subway and LIRR
- Combination of limited and local stop spacing
 - Local stops where there's
 no alternative local service
 - Limited stops closer to hubs
- 25 Rush routes in the new network

Always operate with these stops except overnight in some locations

Example: Union Turnpike

- Q46 makes limited stops west of 188 St
- New Q45 makes local stops

Phasing

Changes by route in two phases

June 29

 2/3 of routes, largely in Eastern Queens

August 31

 1/3 of routes, largely in Northwest and Southwest Queens

Routes without Sunday service will change on the next regular service day.


Why?

• We're implementing routes by bus depot to minimize inconvenience for riders and operators.

Bus stop changes

Signage changes began in February and will continue through the fall in some locations.

- Current service continues
 until the change date for each
 respective route
- Riders should refer to bus stop Guide-A-Ride boxes and mta.info/queensbus for information about Queens Redesign service changes







Starting June 29

The Q111 will make limited stops on Guy R. Brewer Blvd north of Farmers Blvd.

For local stops, take the new Q115, which will run on Guy R. Brewer Blvd between Jamaica and Farmers Blvd.

We're introducing a new Queens bus network. We're expanding the all-day frequent network, adding new overnight service, removing some stops, and adding new connections to major destinations and transfer points.

Changes to the Queens bus network will go into effect in two phases:

- Phase 1: June 29, 2025
- Phase 2: August 31, 2025

Routes without Sunday service will change on either June 30 or September 2.

What's changing

We've taken a fresh look at the map to bring you faster, more reliable service with better connections. To do this, most bus routes have changed, which includes:

- New bus routes and route numbers.
- New Rush routes that get you to the subway faster.
- Changes to bus stops, including stops being relocated or removed.
- Routing changes to reduce turns.

We're updating bus stop signs to prepare for service changes that will be phased in by route on June 29 and August 31, 2025. Current service continues until then, but some signs will reflect future service. Use the MTA app or BusTime to plan your trip.




The Q18 will mostly keep its current routing, but the southern turnaround will be reconfigured. Some stops have been removed.





The Q69 will keep most of its current routing but will terminate near Queens Plaza instead of Court Square. Some stops have been removed.

Changes take effect August 31, 2025

The Q101 will continue to serve Steinway St but will be rerouted on both ends. At its northern end, the route will be shortened to 37 St. For service on 20 Av, take the Q100.

At its southern end, the Q101 will be rerouted from Manhattan to Hunters Point via Jackson Av. For bus service to Manhattan, take the Q32 or Q60.

Some stops have been removed from this route.



Changes take effect August 31, 2025

The Q102 will now connect Long Island City and Roosevelt Island. In Queens, the route will start at Court Square, traveling to Roosevelt Island via Jackson Av, 31 St, and 36 Av.

On Roosevelt Island, the route will be shortened to terminate at the Roosevelt Island Tramway.

- For service on 31 St, take the N/W trains.
- For service on 30 Av, take the Q18.




Q103 Vernon Boulevard Service between Astoria and Hunters Point

The B62 will be rerouted and extended along 21 St in Queens, terminating at the Astoria Houses. Existing B62 service on Jackson Av will be discontinued and replaced with the Q101.
