What's changing?

Your bus stop may change.

We're adding, relocating, and removing hundreds of stops to make your ride faster, more reliable, and more connected.

Your route may change.

We're rerouting some routes for faster and more direct service. And some routes are getting new numbers.

You may see new routes in your area.

We're expanding the network with new and extended routes in more areas.

New Rush routes get you to the subway faster.

Newly designed routes make local stops far from the subway, with limited stops on major streets and near hubs.

What's happening?

Queens is getting a new bus network this summer.

Hello, South Ozone Park

Bus service changes arrive **summer 2025**.

Here's what you need to know.

Q7	Q8	Q9
Q10	Q37	Q41
Q51	Q80	Q112

A fare is required to ride.

Starting August 31

The Q7 will be rerouted on its western end to provide new service along Rockaway Blvd between Liberty and Jamaica Aves.

Current Q7 service to East New York along Sutter and Pitkin Aves will be discontinued and replaced by the Q112.

On its eastern end, the Q7 will be shortened to the JFK Travel Plaza. Service to JFK Cargo Area C will be provided by Port Authority shuttles and the Q3.

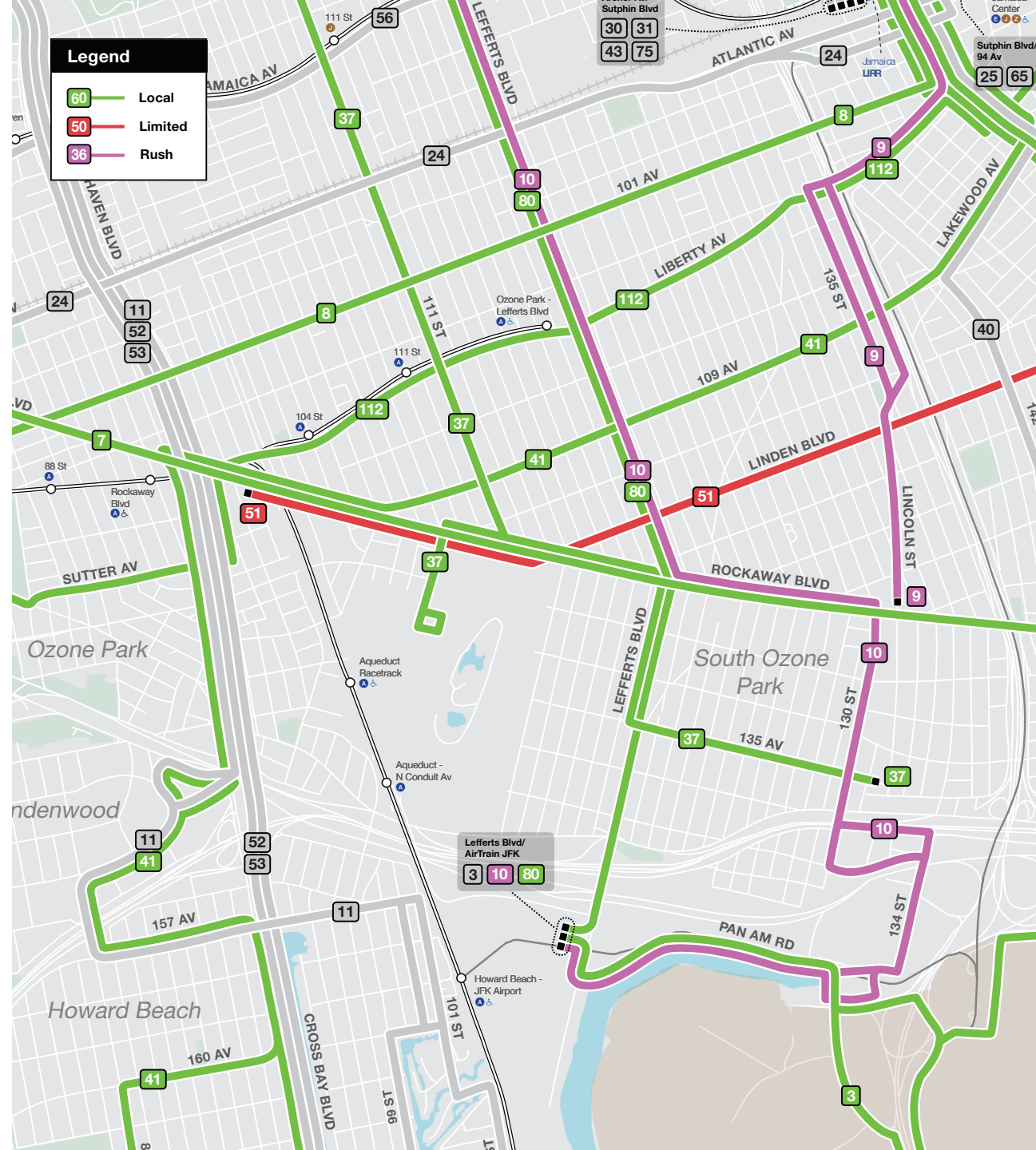
Starting August 31

The Q8 will keep its current routing, but some stops have been removed.

Starting August 31

The Q9 will keep its current routing but make limited stops along Liberty Av and Sutphin Blvd.

- For local service on Liberty Av, take the Q112.
- For local service on Sutphin Blvd, take the Q41 or Q60.



Starting August 31

The Q10 will keep its current routing but make limited stops along Lefferts Blvd. The Q10 Limited will be discontinued.

For local service on Lefferts Blvd
from Kew Gardens to JFK Airport,
take the new Q80.

Starting August 31

The Q37 will still serve 111 St but will be rerouted from 114 St and 133 Av to Rockaway Blvd and Lefferts Blvd.

Some stops have been removed.

Starting August 31

The Q41 will be extended along 109 Av and Sutphin Blvd. Q41 service along 127/128 Sts and Atlantic Av in South Richmond Hill will be discontinued. As an alternative, take the Q8, Q24, rerouted Q41, or Q112.

Some stops have been removed.

Starting June 29

The Q51 will provide a new east-west link along Linden Blvd between Cambria Heights and Ozone Park.

Starting August 31

The new Q80 will replace the Q10 limited branch, providing more frequent and new overnight service along the entire length of Lefferts Blvd.

Starting June 29

The Q112 will be extended west into East New York along Sutter and Pitkin Aves on the current Q7 routing. Some stops have been removed.
