The Q11 will be combined with the Q21.

Existing Q11 service between 157 Av and Pitkin Av will be discontinued. Riders can instead use the A train, Q52/Q53 SBS, or new Q11.

The Q21 will be discontinued.

New Q11 service will be split between three main variants:

- Queens Center to Pitkin Av
- Queens Center to 157 Av/Cross Bay Blvd via Lindenwood
- Queens Center to 165 Av/96 St via 104 St in both directions

Some bus stops have been removed.



The Q52 will be extended to Beach 50 St.

There are no changes to the Q53.
