Q32 Q60

Starting August 31

Q32/Q60 service on Queens Plaza North will be discontinued and some stops have been removed.



Starting June 29

The Q39 routing will mostly stay the same. The northern turnaround will be revised to use Jackson Av in both directions, terminating at Queens Plaza.

Some stops have been removed.



Q66

Starting June 29

The new Q63 will run the length of Northern Blvd between Flushing and Long Island City, with limited-stop Rush service on both ends. For local service, take the Q66 or Q101.

The Q66 will maintain its existing routing. Some stops have been removed.



Starting June 29

The Q67 will mostly keep its current routing but will terminate at Court Square instead of Queens Plaza.

Some stops have been removed.



Q69 Starting August 31

The Q69 will mostly keep its current routing but will terminate near Queens Plaza instead of Court Square.

Some stops have been removed.

Q101 Starting August 31

The Q101 will continue to serve Steinway St but will be rerouted on both ends. At its northern end, the route will be shortened to 37 St. For service on 20 Av, take the Q100.

To the south, the Q101 will be rerouted from Manhattan to Hunters Point via Jackson Av. For bus service to Manhattan, take the Q32 or Q60.

Some stops have been removed.

Q102 Starting August 31

The Q102 will now connect Long Island City and Roosevelt Island. In Queens, the route will start at Court Square, traveling to Roosevelt Island via Jackson Av, 31 St, and 36 Av.

On Roosevelt Island, the route will be shortened to terminate at the Roosevelt Island Tramway.

- For service on 31 St, take the
 N w trains.
- For service on 30 Av, take the Q18.
- For service through Queensbridge, take the Q103.

Q103

Starting August 31

The Q103 will be rerouted south of Queensbridge and extended west to the waterfront.

Some stops have been removed.

B62

Starting August 31

The B62 will be rerouted and extended along 21 St in Queens, terminating at the Astoria Houses. Existing B62 service on Jackson Av will be discontinued and replaced with the Q101.
