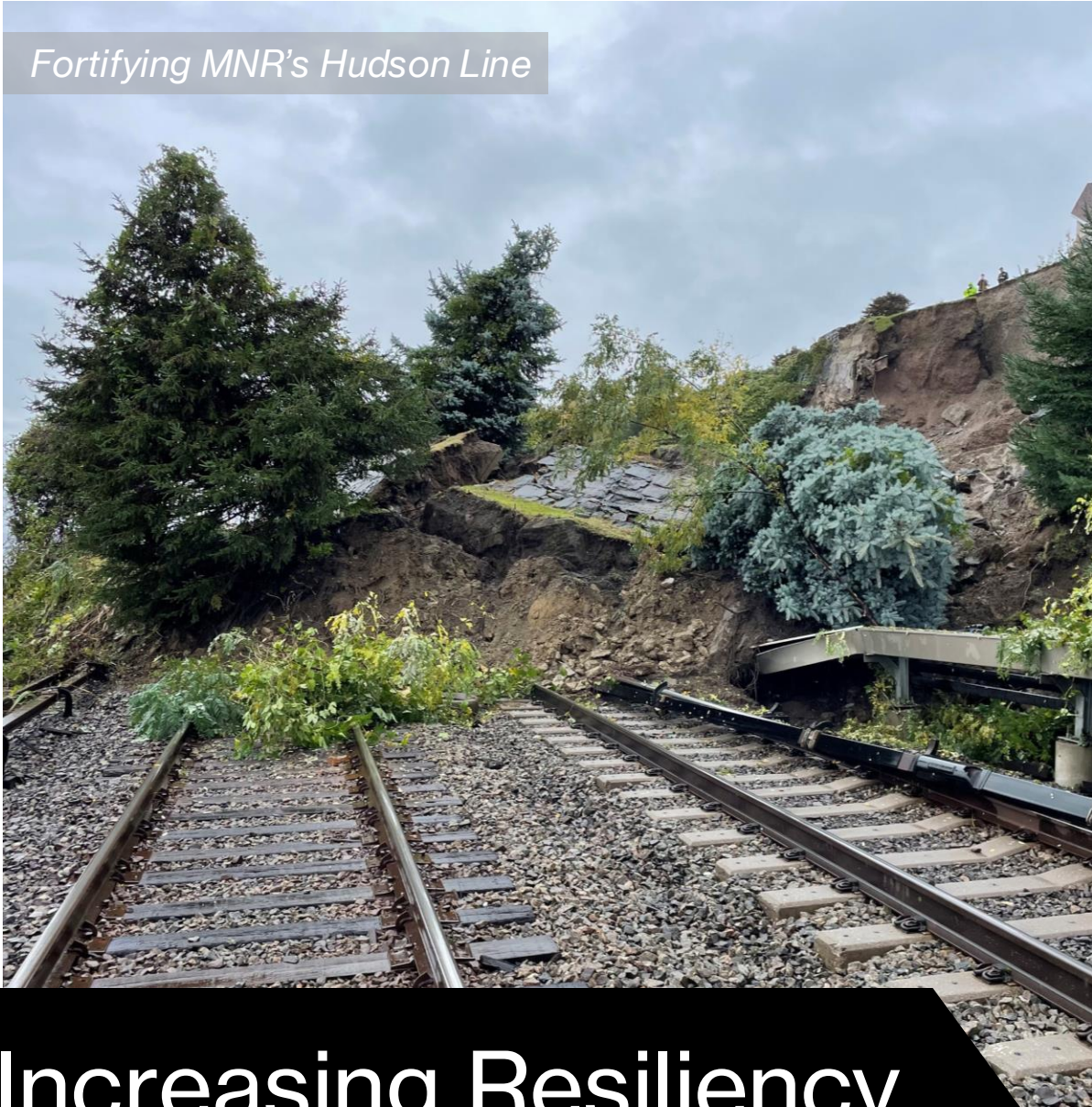

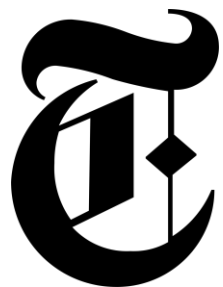

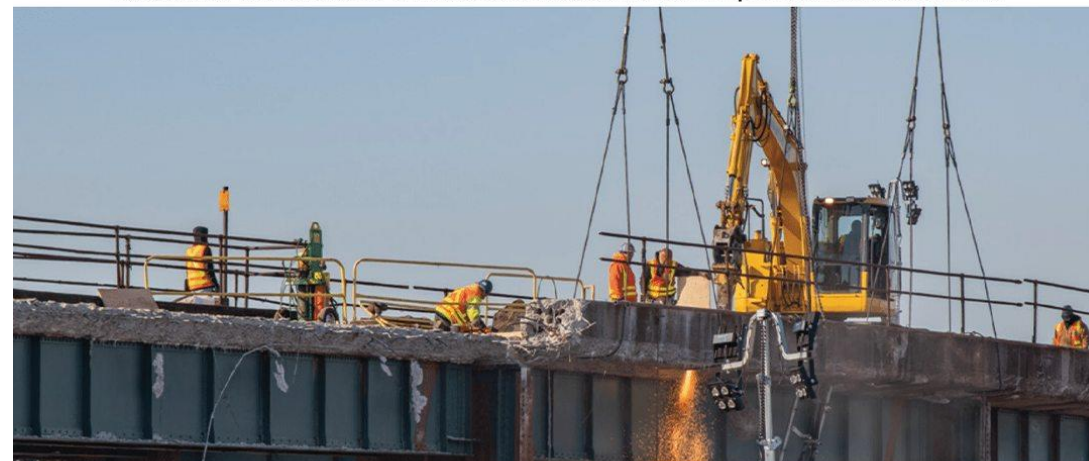

Major Hiring Push Underway

MTA's Outlook Stable Overall

- **Revenues higher than budgeted**
- **Expenses in line to forecast apart from Paratransit despite increases in service**
- **Deficit reduced by ~\$200 million over the last year**
- **On track for forecasted \$500 million in annual cost savings**
