Travel tips

- Farmingdale is the LIRR station for service to the Ryder Cup. Customers will board buses for the short ride to Bethpage State Park.
- To save on fares and avoid lines, buy round-trip train tickets to/from Farmingdale in advance before boarding from the TrainTime app (the LIRR's mobile ticketing app) or any LIRR ticket machine or ticket office.
Please activate your e-ticket right before boarding.
- Tickets may be checked at Farmingdale Station in both directions, so please take your ticket with you and have it ready for inspection. If you bought your ticket on TrainTime, activate it prior to boarding your train to the tournament and when you return to Farmingdale Station after the tournament.
- Listen for station announcements and check digital signs in stations for updates.

- On your return trip, please allow adequate time to walk to the shuttle bus stop for the trip to Farmingdale Station. Tickets will be collected before boarding.
- Trains will leave promptly at scheduled departure times.

- Under no circumstances will personal items, bags, or luggage be stored or held at LIRR Farmingdale.

There is no parking available at Farmingdale Station or Bethpage State Park during the Ryder Cup

Fans who travel by car must park at Jones Beach, then board shuttle buses to the golf course. Because Farmingdale Station is on the LIRR's Ronkonkoma Branch, Suffolk County residents traveling west to Farmingdale should know that they can park at any LIRR station east of Farmingdale (**Ronkonkoma, Central Islip, Brentwood, Deer Park, and Wyandanch**) for free on weekends, then take a train to the Ryder Cup.

Nassau County residents traveling east to Farmingdale can park on weekends at the **Mineola Intermodal Center at Mineola Station**. There is a fee to park at Jones Beach and the Mineola Intermodal Center.
