

Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Construction Activities near Baker Avenue and White Plains Road

The Penn Station Access Project is advancing construction on the Amtrak right-of-way (ROW) near Baker Avenue and White Plains Road. Beginning on or about September 23, 2025, construction vehicles and equipment will be accessing the Amtrak ROW via an access point behind the residences along Baker Avenue near White Plains Road. Construction activities will be performed during both daytime shifts and overnight shifts intermittently for approximately three to four months. Sidewalk access and parking lanes will be maintained.

This work must be performed during day and night shifts to accelerate the construction and maintain existing rail service along the Northeast Corridor. Our contractor has a noise mitigation plan in place compliant with NYC Noise Control Code and DEP guidelines. We will continue to update the community on construction changes as work progresses.
