Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Weekend Work: Overnight Full Closures of Bronx River Parkway between Pelham Parkway and Cross Bronx Expressway

The Penn Station Access Project will be performing weekend work to pull overhead signal cables above the Bronx River Parkway. To safely perform this work, the Bronx River Parkway will be closed <u>overnight</u>, when vehicular traffic is at its lightest, to all vehicular traffic October 31 to November 3 <u>and</u> November 14 to November 17. The parkway will remain open during daytime hours. Please see below for detailed work hours.

Detours will be in place to direct vehicles to exit northbound and southbound Bronx River Parkway.

- Vehicles traveling northbound on Bronx River Parkway will take Exit 4 and follow the detour to reenter via Pelham Parkway.
- Vehicles traveling southbound on Bronx River Parkway will take Exit 7E and follow the detour to reenter via E. 174th Street.

We will continue to update the community on traffic pattern changes as work progresses in the coming months. We appreciate your understanding and patience while we advance this vital transit equity project.
