

Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Construction Activities and Tree Removal on 1st St between Monterey Avenue and Corona Avenue

The Penn Station Access Project is advancing construction on the Metro-North Railroad right-of-way (MNR ROW) near 1st Street. **Beginning on or about October 20, 2025, tree removal and clearing and grubbing activities will occur between 7 AM and 3 PM for approximately one week on 1st Street between Monterey and Corona Avenues.** This work is necessary to create a construction laydown area in preparation for signal and power cable improvements on the MNR ROW. The laydown area will remain in place until Spring 2026.

Traffic on 1st Street will be maintained. Sidewalk access on the south side of 1st Street will be maintained. The area will be restored with new shrubs and trees upon the completion of work at this location. We will continue to update the community on construction changes as work progresses.
