## General Info

### Peak tickets are required on trains that:

- Arrive at Grand Central on weekdays between 6 AM – 10 AM
- Depart from Grand Central on weekdays between 6 AM – 9 AM and between 4 PM – 8 PM

### Reduced fares

#### Not available on inbound AM Peak trains.

- Senior (65+)/People with Disabilities and Medicare customers will be charged full fare.

Half fares are available on all other trains.

- Senior (65+)/People with Disabilities and Medicare customers **must present proper ID. See details**

### Bicycles

- Bicycles NOT permitted** on:
  - inbound AM peak trains
  - on trains with the NO BIKE symbol
  - outbound PM peak trains
  - or on some holidays

### Weekday off-peak trains

unless noted allow a maximum 4 bicycles per train:  
no more than 2 bicycles per car.

### Weekend off-peak trains

allow a maximum 8 bicycles per train:  
no more than 2 bicycles per car.
