- Rescue Techniques and Procedures
- Communication and Command Procedures

- Stabilization Procedures for all Long Island Rail Road Equipment

Rail Safety Education

The Training Course is presented as a two part Course

Part One – Classroom Session

This session is held at your agency. The session will consist of a multimedia presentation administered by Long Island Rail Road instructors.

Part Two – Hands On Training

The LIRR provides two options:

Option One – Equipment Walk Through

This option provides recognition of Long Island Rail Road equipment, safety hazards, emergency equipment location and familiarization.

Option Two – Evolution Exercises*

Providing hose handling, entry procedures, evacuation procedures, search and rescue techniques, and communication/command procedures.

****Nassau and Suffolk Departments***

For Nassau and Suffolk County agencies, the Long Island Rail Road Safety and Awareness and Emergency Response Operation Training is provided in cooperation with Nassau and Suffolk County Fire Academies to emergency response personnel. Fire Academy instructors will instruct in conjunction with Long Island Rail Road instructors and Fire Marshals.



Multiple Agency

Emergency Operations Drills

The Long Island Rail Road Fire Marshals in cooperation with Nassau and Suffolk County Fire Academies, the MTA Police Department and local authorities provide Multiple/Mass Casualty Incident (M.C.I.) style training drills involving Long Island Rail Road equipment. These drills are only accomplished through advanced planning and preparation with the Long Island Rail Road.

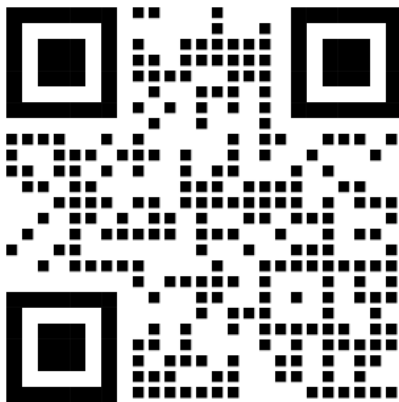
