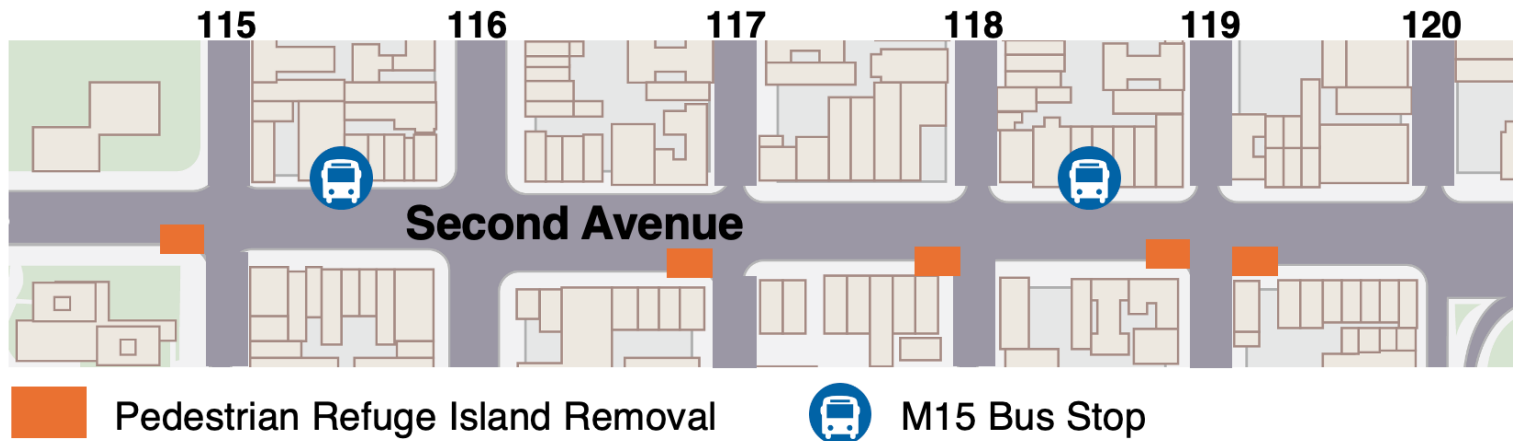

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

SECOND AVENUE – PEDESTRIAN REFUGE ISLAND REMOVALS AS SOON AS FEBRUARY 17, 2026



Connect Plus Partners (C+P), the MTA’s contractor for Contract 2 (C2) of Phase 2 the Second Avenue Subway (SAS2) project, will begin to remove the pedestrian refuge islands along Second Avenue in preparation for future traffic shifts.

PLEASE BE ADVISED: To remove pedestrian refuge islands, the following safety measures will be implemented along Second Avenue and adjacent side streets:

TRAFFIC CONTROL & LANE CLOSURES

- Placement of temporary cones and traffic drums with advance warning signage
- Vehicular access will be maintained along Second Ave. and side streets

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS AND SAFETY

- Flaggers to direct pedestrians
- Crosswalk pavement markings
- Installation of signage for cyclists near construction access points

Trees located within the pedestrian refuge islands will be removed, in coordination with NYC Parks.
