## New 48-Inch Sewer Pipes Arrive At 110 Street And Second Avenue

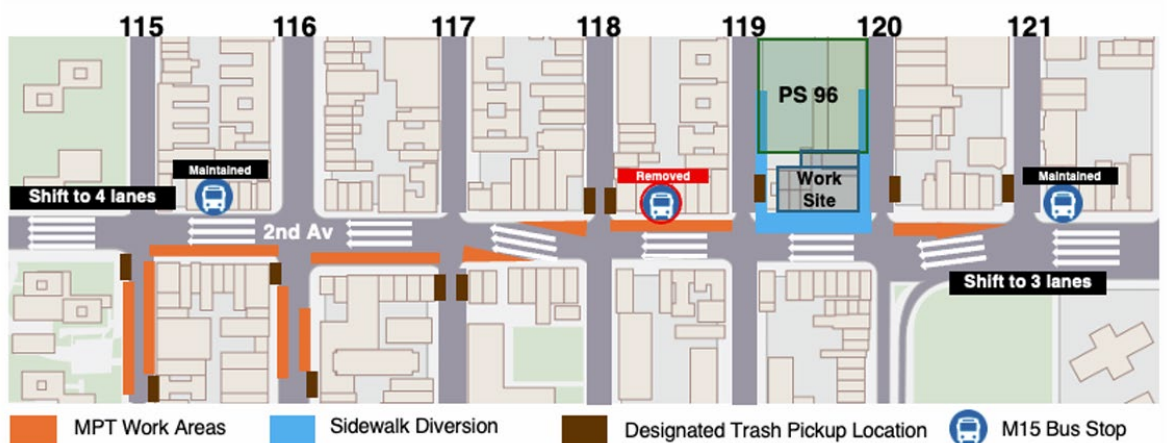


The contractor received a delivery of 48-inch DIP (Ductile Iron Pipe) sewer pipes at the corner of 110 Street and Second Avenue. These new sewer pipes will be installed along the east side of Second Avenue between 105 and 106 Street. As the MTA prepares to build the new 106 Street Q train station, these new upgrades to the existing sewer system will extend the life of these utilities for 70 to 100 years.

## Contract 2 - Sidewalk Cutbacks Rerouting Traffic On Second Avenue

To make space for early work on Contract 2, including building demolition, please be aware that sidewalk cutbacks are occurring on the east side of Second Avenue from 120 to 118 Street. These sidewalk cutbacks are required to reroute traffic on Second Avenue and to allow us to work on the west side of the avenue while maintaining traffic flow. This reduction in traffic lanes will allow the contractor to coordinate the demolition of four buildings on the west side of Second Avenue between 119 and 120 Street. During this work the local M15 bus stop between 118 and 119 Street will be temporarily removed. Please use the 116 or the 121 Street bus stops until the work is complete. All sidewalks will be restored at the completion of the project.

Keeping the community informed about the status of construction along the corridor is an important part of the MTA's interaction with the community.
