****UPDATE**: W. 255th Street Reconstruction Project**

MTA Construction & Development will be replacing the MTA-owned W. 255th Street roadway at Riverdale Station from the end of June through approximately **December 2026** to improve roadway conditions and repair the drainage system to prevent flooding at the station.

On June 22nd, W. 255th Street **will** be closed and temporary traffic pattern changes will be in effect. To maintain access and traffic circulation, W. 254th Street and Railroad Terrace will be temporarily converted to two-way traffic.

The Hudson Rail Link bus pick-up area **will** be temporarily relocated to the current passenger drop-off area, where buses will continue to meet passengers.

Construction activity and modified traffic patterns may affect Hudson Rail Link bus service and travel times. Every effort will be made to maintain schedules and preserve connections with Metro-North trains. **However, please allow extra travel time during your commute due to these construction activities throughout this period.**

Passengers are encouraged to use caution when traveling through the area and to follow all posted signage and directions from onsite personnel.

Please note that additional temporary changes may occur throughout the project as construction activities and operational needs evolve.
