

21 NYCRR § 1021.2 Vehicle limitations and Weigh-in-Motion Violation Monitoring

(a) The toll rates set forth in section 1021.1 of this Part are applicable only to vehicles which do not exceed the following limits:

(1) Width-overall, including load:

Tunnels-8 ft. 6 in.

Bridges-9 ft 6 in.

(2) Height-overall, from roadway:

Tunnels-12 ft. 1 in.

(3) Weight:

Tunnels and bridges-limits as prescribed by 34 Rules of the City of New York section 4-15(b).

(b) No vehicles exceeding the limits set forth in this section shall be permitted in or upon the facilities, except by prior arrangement made through the Metropolitan Transportation Authority Central Permit Office. In addition to paying the crossing charge set forth in section 1021.1 of this

Part, vehicles requiring special handling shall also pay a further toll at the greater amount of either: (1) the applicable rate for using fare media other than NYCSC E-ZPass, commonly referred to as Tolls by Mail, set forth in section 1021.1 of this Part ; or (2) the rate of \$55, which latter rate may be subject to adjustment at the authority's sole discretion in order to cover its costs attributable to such vehicles.

(c) Weigh-in-Motion Violation Monitoring System.

(1) Liability. The liability of an owner pursuant to section 385-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law for a violation of section 385 of such law shall be \$650 for each such violation.

(2) Additional penalties. If the owner fails to respond to the notice of liability within 30 days after the mailing of the notice of liability, an additional penalty of \$25 may be assessed pursuant to subdivision (e) of section 385-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.

(3) Notice of liability. The notice of liability must be in accordance with the requirements of subdivision (g) of section 385-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law and in such form and substance as prescribed by the director of the New York City Parking Violations Bureau.

(4) Effective dates. This section will remain in effect for as long as section 385-a of the Vehicle and Traffic Law shall remain in effect.
