## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY MOBILIZATION BEGINS AT 106 ST AND 2 AV STARTING JUNE 15, 2026

### **PLEASE BE ADVISED:**

In April 2026, the MTA Board approved the award of Contract 3 (C3) for Phase 2 of the Second Avenue Subway. C3 will construct the 106 St Q Station and its connecting tunnels.

Starting June 15, 2026, C3 will be mobilizing at the northeast corner **106 St and 2 Av**, in the current plaza area, future 106 St Station **Entrance 1 (E1)**.



Contractors will set up maintenance and protection of traffic (MPT) in this area. Preliminary work will involve tree removals, preconstruction building inspections, borings, instrumentation and monitoring equipment installation.

### **What to expect:**

- Contractors will be working from **Monday-Friday from 7am-3:30pm**
- **Increased noise levels**
- **Increased truck traffic** for material delivery

### **Keeping you informed:**

As construction progresses with C3, residents and merchants will see work crews, equipment and fenced areas throughout the work area from 105 St to 110 St on 2 Av. We are committed to keeping you informed about how the work will be executed and when the work will reach certain areas.
