# **Rules:**

### Draw an Original Safety Super He

#### Grades K - 5:

To enter, submit a <u>Name</u> for our new Safety Super Hero (one entry per student), using "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme.

#### Grades 6 - 8:

To enter, submit your original **Drawing** of a brand-new Safety Super Hero (one entry per student), using "Safety Along The Tracks" as this hero's theme and message.

#### <u>Grades 9 – 12:</u>

To enter, submit a <u>Slogan</u> or <u>Lyrics</u> for our brand-new Safety Super Hero (one entry per student), using "Safety Along The Tracks" as the theme.

Entries must be e-mailed to <u>tracks@lirr.org</u> using "Safety Super Hero Contest" in the subject line and must include the School's name / Teacher's name, Student's name, address, and daytime phone number.

- Contest is open to entries received between October 15 December 15, 2021; winners will be announced by February 1, 2022.
- If the parent or guardian of a winner under age 18 or winner 18 or older consents, we will have the original entry displayed at various LIRR stations and use the three winning entries combined to promote safety on the LIRR.

- NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Contests run from October 15<sup>th</sup> through December 15<sup>th</sup> 2021. Contest is open to all full-time elementary, middle and high school students. To enter Safety Super Hero Contest <u>Grades K 5</u>, the student will create an original name for the Safety Super Hero. <u>Grades 6 8</u>, the student will create an original drawing on an "8 ½ x 11" sheet of paper which includes the student's name. The Super Hero's look should reflect "Safety Along The Tracks". <u>Grades 9 12</u>, the student will create a slogan or original lyrics of 100 words or less in Microsoft Word format about the subject of the "LIRR Safety Super Hero". To submit a contest entry, email the entry to: tracks@lirr.org with the subject "Safety Super Hero", and in the body of the email include your <u>School's Name</u>, <u>Address</u>, <u>Phone Number</u>, <u>Grade</u>, and <u>Teacher's Name</u>. Grades 6 12 students must also include a Full Name, Address and Daytime Phone Number, including Area Code. All entries must be received by **December 15, 2021**.
- 2. All personal information about a student included with an entry will only be used to administer the contest and contact the student unless, after the initial winners are selected, other uses are authorized by the student's parent or guardian (if student under age 18) and the student if 18 or older.
- 3. Winning entries: All winning entries will be used to promote Long Island Rail Road Safety. Grades K 5 winner will get to name our new Safety Super Hero. Grades 6 8 winner will have their drawing used to design the look of the new Safety Super Hero. Grades 9 12 winner's slogan or lyrics will be used to support the media needs of LIRR Safety programs. The winner(s) and alternates will be selected by the Long Island Rail Road. The decisions of the Long Island Rail Road are final. The Long Island Rail Road is not responsible for any entry which is not received or opened due to any internet or other technology deficiency or failure. Winner(s) will be notified by the Long Island Rail Road through their principal and or teacher via email and / or by telephone by February 1, 2022. A winner must respond to Long Island Rail Road within 72 hours after the notice is given, or an alternate will be selected. In addition, an alternate will be designated the winner if, within five days after the winner's response is given, the parent or guardian of the winner under the age of 18 or a winner 18 years or older, does not consent and agree to grant Long Island Rail Road the rights to own and use the winner's entry as specified in a form provided by the LIRR.
- 4. Limit one entry per person. The Long Island Rail Road disclaims liability for late or non-receipt of an entry for any reason, including internet or other technology deficiency or failure. An entrant must be a student in the grade range applicable to the entry and, at the request of LIRR provide proof of school enrollment and identity. Children of an employee of the LIRR are not eligible to enter.
- 5. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
- 6. In case the same or substantially similar name, drawing, or lyric is submitted by two or more people and more than one of the entries is being considered for a winning entry, only the first entry received will be considered.
- 7. Long Island Rail Road reserves the right to modify or supplement the contest rules and to cancel this contest in whole or in part at any time for any reason.
- 8. This contest is governed by applicable State of New York and Federal laws.
