# CityTicket

CityTicket gives you off-peak trips on LIRR or Metro-North within NYC for just \$5.



## Where you can go

CityTicket is good for trips on LIRR or Metro-North that are entirely within NYC.

## When you can go

CityTicket is available seven days a week for off-peak travel.

## How much it costs

CityTicket is just \$5 one-way.

## Where you can get it

CityTicket is available for purchase at ticket offices, on ticket machines, and on MTA eTix, but not on trains.

## When you can use it

You have to use CityTicket the day you buy it.

# Atlantic Ticket

Atlantic Ticket lets you ride between Southeast Queens and Brooklyn for just \$5 on LIRR, or get a weekly ticket and a MetroCard for \$60.



## Where you can go

Travel between LIRR stations in Rosedale, Laurelton, Locust Manor, St. Albans, Queens Village, Hollis, Jamaica, East New York, Bedford-Stuyvesant, and Downtown Brooklyn. Then continue your trip with a transfer to subways and buses.

## When you can go

Atlantic Ticket is available for travel at all times.

## How much it costs

A one-way Atlantic Ticket is \$5. You can get a combined weekly Atlantic Ticket and a 7-Day Unlimited MetroCard for \$60.

## Where you can get it

Atlantic Ticket is available for purchase at ticket offices at Jamaica and Atlantic Terminal. One-way and round-trip tickets are available at all ticket machines in eligible stations. Weekly tickets are available at full-service ticket machines in eligible stations.

## When you can use it

You have to use your one-way Atlantic Ticket the day you buy it. Weekly tickets work from Saturday to Friday.
