OMNY is the new way to pay for MTA subways and local buses.

Pay with:

Bank Card with OMNY



OMNY Card

Your OMNY ride costs the same as a fare with MetroCard.

OMNY subway and local bus transfers are free, just like with MetroCard.

No sign-up necessary. Just tap and go.

WHAT IS FARE CAPPING?

Weekly fare capping with OMNY makes riding MTA subways and local buses more affordable, more flexible, and more fair.

Starting each Monday, after you pay 12 fares with the same device or card, all additional rides are free through Sunday. You'll always get the best deal each week, automatically.

HOW IT WORKS

- **Pay for 12 rides any week starting Monday, ride free through Sunday.**
- **The fare cap is earned on paid OMNY trips on subways and local buses.**
- **Free transfers are included**, but they don't count towards your free ride cap.
- **Tap with the same device or card for every trip.** Even if your phone and wearable are connected to the same bank card, their ride totals can't be combined. Everything you tap has its own cap.
- **You don't have to sign up for anything.** You'll get your free rides automatically, as soon as you earn them.
- **You can track your progress with a secure and free OMNY account.** Register at omny.info, link your payment method to your account, and your progress will appear automatically.
