## Holidays

## Ticket Types

### One Way

Good for one ride from time of purchase until 4 A.M. the next day. Sold for:

Peak - Valid on all trains.

Off Peak - Additional fare payable to the conductor if used on weekday trains marked Peak AM or PM herein.

### Day Pass

Good for unlimited rides within the ticketed zones from time of purchase until 4 A.M. the next day.

Lower prices on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

### Weekly

Unlimited rides Saturday through Friday. On sale the Wednesday before the Saturday that the ticket becomes valid. Non-transferable.

### Monthly

Unlimited rides during the calendar month indicated on the ticket.

On sale starting on the 25th of the month prior. Non-transferable.

### Senior/People with Disabilities and Medicare Customers

Save 50% off the one way peak fare. Valid from time of purchase until 4 A.M. the next day.

Seniors must be 65 or older.

Valid ID must be presented when buying and using tickets.

### Family Fare

Children aged 5-17 can ride for \$1 when accompanied by a fare-paying adult. Up to four children may ride for a dollar each with one adult. A 5th child or any additional children would have to purchase a child ticket fare.

### Children's Fare

Children under 5 ride free.

Children ages five (5) through eleven (11) traveling alone, and children in excess of four per adult, will pay the One-Way Half fare (peak or off-peak), as applicable.

Unaccompanied children ages 12-17 will pay the adult fare.

### Refunds

Refunds are only available on monthly and weekly tickets, and are subject to a \$10 processing fee per transaction. The cost of two rides per day will be deducted for each day the ticket was in your possession.
